Received via protocol. Spoke to Titusville Police(TPD) Cpl. Johnson via telephone. 321-698-9712. Cpl. Johnson states 16 year old Briana Almquist witnessed her step father, David Almquist, choking the family cat, "Gizmo," then threw him across room. The cat is severely injured, and owner Kristi Almquist cannot afford Vet care.

9/7/09 2317 hours Arrived on scene. Met with TPD Cpl. Johnson and TPD Officer N. Van Cott #779. Cell 321-544-1870. Titusville Police Officers are combing the area for suspect David Almquist (DOB 4/13/61). He is being charged with battery, animal cruelty, and violation of felony probation. Met with Briana Almquist and her biological father. Photographed inside of house where cat was thrown against wall on back porch. Placed the limp cat into a carrier for transport to Animal Emergency and Critical Care Center(EMC). "Gizmo's" right front leg is turned inward, and appears the bone may be broken. The cat has labored breathing, and may have internal injuries. Met with Kristi Almquist at her place of employment-CVS on US 1 and Garden St. Mrs. Almquist signed "Gizmo" over to Brevard Animal Services and Enforcement (BASE). She has only had the cat for three months. No vaccine or license information available.

9/8/09 0118 hours

"Gizmo" examined by Dr. Edward T. Marion, DVM at EMC. BASE Sgt. Robinson #26 authorized exam and radiographs. The radiographs confirmed a fractured humerus on right front leg. The cat may heal without surgery per Dr. Marion. Left cat overnight for observation and pain medications administered. Dr. Marion will send copies of xrays to Dr. R. Asher, DVM at South Animal Care Center. This Officer will pick statement of exam for pending criminal case and deliver to TPD Officer Van Cott on his next duty day, September 11, 2009.

Received phone call from South Animal Care Center(SACC) employee, Cynthia Morris. She stated Mrs. Almquist called the animal shelter checking the status of cat, "Gizmo." Advised Cynthia Morris the owner was not able to afford Vet care for injuries inflicted by her husband, and the cat has been signed over to Brevard Animal Services and Enforcement. The cat will not be returned to anyone in the household pending investigation. The cat is under care of SACC Dr. R. Asher, DVM.
