**10/20/2009** Requester called back and said dog is bleeding and has skin ripped off and face is swollen.

**10/20/2009** Cpl. Piccolella (46)

Animal Enforcement Officer made contact with requester(s) (Gail Wills, Eric Bryan) at (1048 Fern Ave., Cocoa 32922), to investigate an alleged criminal animal cruelty complaint. Ms. Wills stated that her cousin (Kenta Trevall Wyns - 1119 Fern Ave., Cocoa 32922), punched his canine numerous times on the facial region. She and her son (Eric Bryan) allegedly witnessed the incident that occurred on Tues. (10-20-09) at approximately 1530 hrs. She further stated that this isn't the first time that he has beaten his canine. Ms. Wills observed numerous abrasion(s) and swollen area(s) to the facial region. Received statement(s) from both witnesses on scene.

Animal Enforcement Officer made contact with (Kenta Trevall Wyns) at (1119 Fern Ave., Cocoa 32922). Identified Mr. Wyns by his valid social security card (# 265-85-6182). Dispatch was unable to find any animal(s) registered to Mr. Wyns or previous animal cruelty complaint(s) in the past. Mr. Wyns invited Animal Enforcement Officer to enter the residence, to insure that the reported canine wasn't injured or in need of immediate vet. care. Sgt. Robinson notified. Animal Enforcement Officer and Cocoa Police Department law enforcement officer (D. Tabor - ID 83), entered the residence and couldn't locate any evidence to substantiate that a crime had taken place. No animal(s) were observed inside the residence or outside of the property. Animal Enforcement Officer asked Mr. Wyns numerous times if he owned a canine and punched same in the facial region. His answer was an emphatic no each and every time.

Ms. Wills was advised of the investigative findings and will call Animal Enforcement Officer when-if visual of Mr. Wyns canine is regained. Unable to pursue criminal animal cruelty charges at this time.

**10/22/2009** AEO #39 Hahn

Arrived on scene and made contact with Cocoa PD officer Green; with whose assistance I was able to capture an injured tan female pit bull.

After reporting the pit bull's injuries (severe injuries to the neck, face, and eye regions) to the Cpl on duty (Cpl Piccolella #46), it was discovered that this canine fit the description of a possible animal cruelty case that our department was already working.

I then drove to 1048 Fern St, the address of the requester of the possible animal cruelty case (ref activity A09-021808), who positively identified the canine I picked up as the same dog. I then notified Cpl Piccolella of the findings.

Canine transported to emc by #47 Miller.

**10/22/2009** Cpl. Piccolella (46)

Animal Enforcement Officer (39) requested authorization to transport an injured stray canine to Animal Emergency And Critical Care Center Of Brevard for treatment-evaluation. The canine was picked up by AEO 39 on (Thomas St., Cocoa 32922). Reference (A# 09-021970). A Cocoa Police Department law enforcement officer assisted AEO 39 on scene. Cpl. Piccolella inquired if the injuries were to the neck and facial region and requested an animal description. The injuries and canine description were consistent with a criminal animal cruelty case, that I was investigating on Fern Ave. AEO 39 was advised to transport the injured canine to (1048 Fern Ave., Cocoa 32922) for a positive identification. Animal Enforcement Officer(s) (39, 46) and Cocoa law enforcement officer (Green) made contact with witnesses on scene. The injured canine was positively identified as the animal owned by (Kenta Trevali Wyns - 1119 Fern Ave., Cocoa 32922).

Sgt. Robinson notified. Observed numerous contusion(s)-laceration(s) to the neck and facial region. One (1) eye was closed, due to extreme trauma by unknown means. Photograph(s) attached to (A# 09-021808). Officer Green determined enough probable cause to place owner (Kenta Treval Wyns) under arrest for criminal animal cruelty. Mr. Wyns intentionally committed an act to his canine, which resulted in excessive or repeated infliction of unnecessary pain or suffering. Cocoa Police Department will pursue criminal animal cruelty charge(s). Mr. Wyns was processed at the Cocoa Police Dept. and will then be transported to Sharpes Jail. Animal Enforcement Officer(s) (39,46) provided evidence from witness statement(s) and photograph(s) to law enforcement officer (Green). Mr. Wyns admitted guilt when questioned by arresting officer. Reference Cocoa Police Dept. case report # (09-7302).

Cpl. Miller transported injured canine to Animal Emergency And Critical Care Center Of Brevard for treatment. Canine was anesthetized by attending vet., in order to treat severe injuries to the neck and facial region. The animal will be transported to the South Animal Care Center on Friday (10-23-09). Cpl. Miller transported witness statement(s) to the South Office. Brevard County Animal Services will pursue "Fitness To Own" on said canine.

**10/28/2009** Ofc. Mercer #42 10/28/09

Picked up medical report from Dr. Christopher Beale, DVM at Animal Emergency and Critical Care Center of Brevard (EMC). The report indicates the wounds on canine, a female Pit Bull owned by Kenta Wyns, were caused by a chemical burn, trauma, and infection. The Pit Bull was admitted to EMC on October 22, 2009 with an elevated body temperature of 103.3 degrees, and was very thin and febrile. Canine examined by Dr. Beale, DVM, for raw, scabbing, infected areas on head and entire ventral neck. Canine was sedated with an injectable anesthesia, and wounds cleaned and treated by Dr. Beale, DVM. Canine currently receiving continued wound care and antibiotics at South Animal Care Center by Brevard Animal Services and Enforcement Veterinarian Dr. Robbie Asher, DVM.

**10/28/2009** Cpl. Piccolella (46)

Animal Enforcement Officer made phone contact with Cocoa Police Department records clerk, who provided case report to same (CR 09-7302). Arresting law enforcement officer (Green) is currently on workers compensation. The records clerk further stated that she was unable to locate his arrest report at this time. CAD report was faxed to Brevard County Animal Services (Attn: Capt. Brown) on Wed. (10-28-09).
